Freedom to Move: Movement and Dance

With People Who Have Disabilities

9 am – 12.30 pm

This experiential workshop will cover practices and principles for using movement & dance with children and adults who have intellectual and physical disabilities. The workshop is for dance/movement therapists, community dance practitioners, disability professionals, special education teachers, dance teachers and others wanting to develop skills in working with these populations through movement and dance. Experienced practitioners and those who are new to the field are welcome.



Assessment and Evaluation in Dance Movement Therapy

1.30 – 5 pm

Theory will be complemented by practical exercises in evaluation as well as using the tool presented to analyse video material of clients' participation in a DMT program for people who have an intellectual disability. Also included:

- introducing DMT principles and the evaluation framework to management and other staff
- harmonizing DMT assessment with other assessment frameworks
- engaging non-specialist staff in the assessment process
- coping with time, venue and group size limitations
- reporting to stakeholders; clients, parents, carers and managers

Kim Dunphy (BA, Grad Dip Movement, M.Ed (Dance) is a dance-movement therapist, performing arts educator and community artist experienced with children with special needs, people with disabilities, older adults, psycho-geriatric patients, parents and children's groups. With Jenny Scott, she is the author of *Freedom to Move: Movement and Dance for People with Intellectual Disabilities* (Elsevier 2003).
